Shelter Transfer Program – Animal House exclusively supports open-admission, over-burdened shelters, both statewide and nationally. 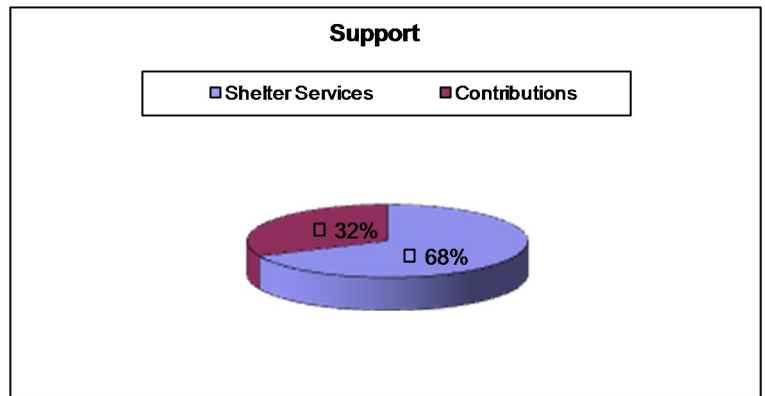

Financials

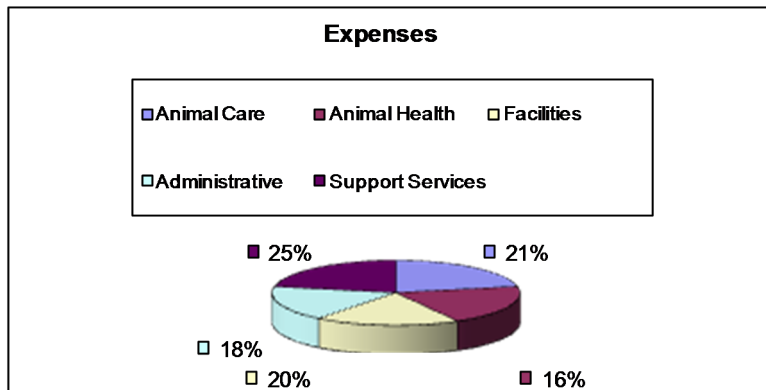
